COVID-19 HEALTH ACKNOWLEDGEMENT & LIABILITY WAIVER

I, _____, and my parent/guardian (if applicable) are aware of the potential spread of COVID-19 that could result in severe illness and potential death. My presence at the 2020 OKC Futurity held in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma ("Event") proves I voluntarily accept this risk by attending the Event and accept sole responsibility for any injury to myself and on behalf of my family, spouse, estate, heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, and personal representatives, including, but not limited to, illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense of any kind, that may be experienced or incurred in connection with my attendance at the Event.

I understand that the risk of being exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the Event may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself, and others, including, but not limited to, OKC Futurity, Better Barrel Races, State Fair Park, and/or its employees, officers, directors, representatives, agents, show staff, volunteers, Event participants/attendees and their families. I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge and hold harmless OKC Futurity, Better Barrel Races, State Fair Park and/or their directors, officers, employees, representatives and agents from any claim associated with allegedly being exposed to or infected by COVID-19 as a result of participating in Event activities and/or being on Event show grounds.

HEALTH PROTOCOLS:

- I have read, understand and agree to comply with the attached COVID-19 Health Protocols and understand and agree that I may be disqualified from participating in the Event and required to leave the Event show grounds should I fail to do so.
- I will, to the best of my ability, practice proper social distancing as recommended by health department directives, as well as practice good hygiene (hand washing, use of hand sanitizer, wearing of a mask if and when required, etc.) and follow other health directives ordered or suggested.

HEALTH REPORTING:

- I have not experienced new or worsening symptoms of possible COVID-19 in the last 14 days, including cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, feeling feverish or a temperature greater than 100°.
- I have not had close contact with a person symptomatic or confirmed to have COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- I have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days. If I have been infected by COVID-19 at any time, I have been medically released to return to normal activities.
- If I develop a fever and symptoms, such as a cough or difficulty breathing while at the Event, or if I am diagnosed with COVID-19 while at the Event, I will self-quarantine and immediately report this information to OKC Futurity show management.

The State of Oklahoma and Oklahoma County in particular, has experienced a significant increase in the number of COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations in the past few months. As a result, we are being required to implement the following protocols to help prevent the county from becoming a hot spot. We want everyone to know that our ability to ensure compliance with these protocols will directly affect our ability to have future events at the OKC Fairgrounds facilities!

COVID-19 HEALTH PROTOCOLS

Exhibitors, vendors, and attendees, whether in the barns, vendor areas or seating areas, shall not congregate in groups larger than 10 people and must follow social distancing guidelines.

Everyone shall maintain a minimum of six (6) feet between themselves and those who are not from their same household or household contact.

Exhibitors, vendors, and attendees will be held responsible for providing and utilizing their own personal protective equipment, including but not limited to face masks, hand sanitizer, gloves, etc.

Show management will provide each exhibitor with one complimentary face covering per exhibitor packet.

Exhibitors, vendors, and attendees are required to wear face masks while in common areas, including but not limited to the stands, check-in, show office, trade show and bathrooms. Face protection while riding or handling a horse is optional.

Social distancing in the barns or outside is required when not wearing face protection. Riders/handlers and individuals on foot must maintain at least six (6) feet of separation from those outside their household or household contact at all times.

Indoor warmup areas are limited to two (2) people/horses per 1000 sq. ft. (This allows up to 60 horses in the Barn 6 Performance Arena or up to 44 horses in the Superbarn warmup pen.)

The event is closed to the public and outside spectators are not permitted. Exhibitors are encouraged to limit the number of people in their group.

Announcer's stand, judges stand and show arena floor (including the alleyway) are off limits to all spectators.

To reduce traffic in the show office, event running orders, results, etc. will be available online and in the event program.

A minimum of two (2) seats should be vacant between persons from a separate household or household contact. Every other row of seats will be blocked off by the facility for safe distancing. Anyone not complying with these requirements will be removed from the arena.

The show office will be open only to those needing information or business in the office and exhibitors are asked to maintain six (6) foot separation while in the show office.

Exhibitors are asked to maintain six (6) foot separation while in line for check-in. Exhibitors will be required to provide a signed Health Acknowledgement and Liability Waiver agreeing to abide by these health protocols.

If you begin exhibiting symptoms or test positive for COVID-19 during the OKC Futurity, please contact show management immediately at 405-364-0274.

Exhibitors, vendors, and attendees failing to abide by these protocols may be subject to removal from the event grounds and forfeiture of fees. *Warnings will be given for a first offense, mandatory discussion with show management for a second offense, and potential removal for a third offense.*

Additional Protocols for Event

Below are additional measures and health protocols to be taken by event management.

Check-in and show office personnel will have a protective barrier separating them from exhibitors.

OKC Futurity event staff and OKC Fairgrounds staff working in jobs that prohibit social distancing will be required to wear masks.

Check-in areas and show office will be sanitized with disinfectant regularly.

Signage will be placed around seating areas and throughout the facility to encourage safe distancing.

Stalls will be assigned so that there is at least one empty stall between stalls groups from each ranch/trainer.

Horse sale will be moved to the Barn 3 Arena to increase ability to maintain adequate social distancing and only registered bidders will be allowed on the arena floor.

Vendors booths will be separated by ten (10) feet or will be provided with a solid barrier separating neighboring booths.

Vendors located in the Superbarn will be restricted to veterinary and horse therapy services only.

Signs will be posted in vendor area indicating a limit of three (3) customers at a time for each 100 sq ft of vendor space.
